The annual meeting was held via Zoom virtual meeting. A quorum was confirmed. Father Daniel Simons, Priest-in-Charge opened the meeting with prayer and a call to order.

WARDEN'S REPORT AND FINANCIAL REVIEW

Wardens Anthony Crisci and George Anderson gave an overview of the 2021 financial summary sharing that St. Paul's ended the year, both in revenues and expenses, on a positive note, being ahead of budget.

Co-Treasurer Chris Spiegelman gave an update on the 2022 budget reporting there was a 5.7% increase in revenue resulting in a surplus.

ELECTION OF OFFICE AND VESTRY MEMBERS

Carol Custus, the Chair of the Nominating Committee, put forth a motion for the slate of candidates to be approved for the 2022 Vestry. The new Vestry members being put forth were Kate Adamson, David Westmoreland, and Marva Cummings. The slate also included Maggie Gomez for co-treasurer and Ginny Balsar for Clerk. The proposed delegates to the Convention of the Dioceses were James McNutt and Bob Giolitto. The motion was seconded by Gail Bindley-Taylor. All nominations were overwhelmingly approved.

GOALS

Father Daniel and the Wardens shared the goals for the parish for the next 11 months which include Expanding a Network of Community Caring and Ministry of Healing; Rebuilding Adult/Children's Formation; and Expanding our Range of Radical Welcome and Creating Partnerships in our Neighborhood. Father Daniel encouraged parishioners to find their passion and participate where they feel called too.

Father Daniel gave a few closing remarks and with prayer closed out the meeting.
