## GATHERING

*As we gather together, light a candle in your own space, and spend a moment in quiet preparation.*

Alleluia! Risen Lord, come walk with us,  
**and teach our hearts to live in you. Alleluia!**

Praise to the holy and undivided Trinity, one God: \*

as it was in the beginning, is now,  
and will be forever. **Amen.**

## PSALMS

We begin with a psalm that invites us to praise:

EASTER INVITATORY PSALM—*from Psalm 146*

Alleluia! Praise God O my soul! \*

I will praise God as long as I live,  
I will sing praises to my God  
while I have my being.

God sets the prisoners free

and opens the eyes of the blind; \*

God lifts up those who are bowed down.

God shall reign forever, \*

your God, O Zion, throughout all  
generations. Alleluia!

Praise to the holy and undivided Trinity, one God:

as it was in the beginning, is now,  
and will be forever. **Amen.**

*We then follow with a Psalm specific to the day.*

## LORD'S PRAYER

We gather all our prayers together in the words Jesus taught us, praying in whichever form or language is your own:

Christ in my soul,  
that I may know my desire;

Christ in my arms,
